A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND ITS  
CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS SHALL COUNT CERTAIN FULL SCHOLARSHIP  
UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS AS RESIDENTS FOR TUITION PURPOSES AND  
AS OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS FOR ANY POLICY LIMITING OUT-OF-STATE  
UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 116-143.6(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the Board of Trustees of a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina elects to do so, it may by resolution adopted consider as residents of North Carolina for tuition purposes only all persons who receive full scholarships to the institution from entities recognized by the institution and attend the institution as undergraduate students. ~~The aforesaid persons shall be considered residents of North Carolina for all purposes by The University of North Carolina.~~ These persons shall count as out-of-state students for any policy adopted by the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina that limits out-of-state undergraduate enrollment."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
