A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE CONTRACTORS THAT WILL BE COMPENSATED BY  
2 FEDERAL ECONOMIC STIMULUS FUNDS TO USE THE FEDERAL E-VERIFY  
3 SYSTEM, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW OR WHERE  
4 NECESSARY IN ORDER TO ENSURE RECEIPT OF FUNDS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and except as required  
8 by federal law or where necessary in order to receive funds disbursed pursuant to the American  
9 Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Public Law 111-005, no funds received pursuant to  
10 that Act shall be used to enter into a contract with an entity that does not participate in the  
11 federal E-Verify program described in section 401(b) of the Illegal Immigration Reform and  
12 Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. § 1324a note).

13 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
