A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT EXPANDING PERMITTED USES OF 911 FUNDS IN FRANKLIN COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 62A-46 reads as rewritten:

"§ 62A-46. **Fund distribution to PSAPs.**

...

(c) Use of Funds. – A PSAP that receives a distribution from the 911 Fund may not use the amount received to pay for the lease or purchase of real estate, cosmetic remodeling of emergency dispatch centers, hiring or compensating telecommunicators, or the purchase of mobile communications vehicles, ambulances, fire engines, or other emergency vehicles. Distributions received by a PSAP may be used only to pay for the following:

(1) The lease, purchase, or maintenance of emergency telephone equipment, including necessary computer hardware, software, and database provisioning, addressing, and nonrecurring costs of establishing a 911 ~~system~~system, and the lease or purchase of an additional communications tower, a multisite simulcast system, microwave connectivity between the sites, site monitoring and alarm system, and grounding and lightning protection.

...."

SECTION 2. This act applies to Franklin County only.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
