A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PERMIT GARBAGE TRUCKS TO STOP ON THE PAVEMENT OF
2 HIGHWAYS OUTSIDE MUNICIPAL LIMITS WHILE COLLECTING GARBAGE OR
3 RECYCLABLE MATERIAL.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-161(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended,
8 upon the paved or main-traveled portion of any highway or highway bridge outside municipal
9 corporate limits unless the vehicle is disabled to such an extent that it is impossible to avoid
10 stopping and temporarily leaving the vehicle upon the paved or main traveled portion of the
11 highway or highway bridge. This subsection shall not apply to a solid waste vehicle stopped on
12 a highway while engaged in collecting garbage as defined in G.S. 20-118(c)(5)g. or recyclable
13 material as defined in G.S. 130A-290(a)(26)."

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to offenses
15 occurring on or after that date.
