HOUSE BILL 969

Short Title: Granville/Registered Land. (Local)

Sponsors: Representative Crawford.

Referred to: Wildlife Resources, if favorable, Judiciary II.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS ON  
3 REGISTERED LAND IN GRANVILLE COUNTY BY ALLOWING THE TRACTS OF  
4 REGISTERED LAND TO BE RECORDED IN THE GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION  
5 SYSTEM.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 SECTION 1. Subsection (f) of Section 2 of Chapter 159 of the 1991 Session Laws,  
8 as amended by Chapter 152 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

9 (f) By September 1 each year, the sheriff must:

- 10 (1) File with the Register of Deeds of Granville County a listing of all tracts of  
11 land accepted by him for registration during the ensuing year. This listing  
12 must contain an abbreviated description of the location of each tract of land  
13 so accepted.
- 14 (2) File with the Register of Deeds a copy of the full description of the  
15 boundaries of each tract accepted for registration that year under subsection  
16 (b). As to the remaining applications accepted, the sheriff must indicate in  
17 his filing with the Register of Deeds the year in which a full description was  
18 filed for that tract that met the requirements of subdivision (2) of subsection  
19 (b).
- 20 (3) File with the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission all of the  
21 material required to be filed with the Register of Deeds under subdivisions  
22 (1) and (2). The sheriff must also furnish the North Carolina Wildlife  
23 Resources Commission with a copy of the signature of each registrant and  
24 agent newly authorized to issue entry permits during the ensuing year, and a  
25 listing of agents no longer authorized to issue entry permits. In addition,  
26 throughout the year as registrants make changes with respect to their  
27 authorized agents or there are amended applications that substitute  
28 registrants, the sheriff must as soon as feasible inform the Commission of  
29 the changes and file with the Commission a copy of the signatures of new  
30 registrants and agents.
- 31 ~~(4) Release for publication by appropriate media with coverage in Granville~~  
32 ~~County the listing described in subdivision (1).~~
- 33 (5) Compile and maintain throughout the ensuing year in his office, so that the  
34 information is freely available to the public, all of the information covered  
35 by this subsection.
- 36 (6) The sheriff shall not be required to meet the filing requirements of  
37 subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection if all tracts accepted for



1                   registration hereunder are shown as a layer in Granville County's Geographic  
2                   Information System in a manner that is accessible to the public and the  
3                   Wildlife Resources Commission free of charge."

4                   **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
