A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE USE OF GOLF CARTS IN THE COMMUNITY OF DEEP RUN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 20-50 and G.S. 20-54, a person may operate a golf cart on any public street or highway within the area west of N.C. Highway 11 to the west, Southwest Creek to the north, the intersection of John Green Smith Road to the east, and the intersection of Old N.C. Highway 11 and the N.C. Highway 11 Bypass to the south.

**SECTION 2.** No person shall operate a golf cart within the area defined in Section 1 of this act while being less than 16 years of age or at night.

**SECTION 3.** This act applies to the community of Deep Run in Lenoir County only.

**SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
