A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR SIGNAGE DIRECTING TRAFFIC TO THE
VIETNAM VETERANS' MEMORIAL AND THE BEIRUT MEMORIAL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Of funds appropriated to the Department of Transportation from the Highway Fund for fiscal year 2010-2011, the Department shall expend up to the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for new signs located along N.C. Highway 24 and U.S. Highway 17 for the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial and the Beirut Memorial that replaces old signs and adds new signage, listing both memorials on one sign, at each of the various locations the signs currently appear along N.C. Highway 24 and U.S. Highway 17.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
