SENATE BILL 203

Short Title: DMV to Issue Special ID Cards/Special Cir. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE A SPECIAL  
3 IDENTIFICATION CARD, FREE OF CHARGE, TO INDIVIDUALS THAT HAVE A  
4 VALID DRIVERS LICENSE THAT IS REVOKED BASED ON AN ADMINISTRATIVE  
5 DECISION REGARDING MEDICAL DISQUALIFICATION.  
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
7 SECTION 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new  
8 section to read:  
9 "**§ 20-15.2. Special Identification cards to be issued when a license has been canceled by**  
10 **the Division for reasons related to a medical or physical condition.**  
11 The Division shall issue a Special Identification card, at no cost, to any person who has  
12 been issued a drivers license but, as a result of a medical or physical condition, the license has  
13 been canceled by the Division. The Special Identification card issued as a result of a  
14 cancellation based on a medical or physical condition shall be valid for a period of time not to  
15 exceed the expiration date of the license canceled by the Division."  
16 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
