A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO DISTRIBUTE
STATE SURPLUS PROPERTY TO FURBISHERS OF COMPUTERS FOR STUDENTS
IN GRADES KINDERGARTEN THROUGH TWELVE.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 143-64.02(2) reads as rewritten:
"(2) "Nonprofit tax exempt organizations" means those nonprofit tax exempt
medical institutions, hospitals, clinics, health centers, school systems,
schools, colleges, universities, furbishers of computers for students in grades
kindergarten through 12, schools for the mentally retarded, schools for the
physically handicapped, radio and television stations licensed by the Federal

physically handicapped, radio and television stations licensed by the Federal Communications Commission as educational radio or educational television stations, public libraries, and civil defense organizations, that have been certified by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt nonprofit organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue

Code of 1954."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
