1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE SPACE ON THE INCOME TAX RETURN FOR INDIVIDUALS TO
3 MAKE DONATIONS FOR EARLY DETECTION OF BREAST AND CERVICAL
4 CANCER AS PROVIDED BY THE BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER CONTROL
5 PROGRAM.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Article 9 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by
8 adding a new section to read:

9 "**§ 105-269.7. Contribution by individual for early detection of breast and cervical cancer.**

10 An individual entitled to a refund of income taxes under Part 2 of Article 4 of this Chapter
11 may elect to contribute all or part of the refund to be used for early detection of breast and
12 cervical cancer at the Cancer Prevention and Control Branch of the Division of Public Health
13 of the Department of Health and Human Services. The Secretary shall provide appropriate
14 language and space on the individual income tax form in which to make the election. The
15 Secretary shall include in the income tax instructions an explanation that the contributions will
16 be used for early detection of breast and cervical cancer only. The election becomes irrevocable
17 upon filing the individual's income tax return for the taxable year.

18 The Secretary shall transmit the contributions made pursuant to this section to the State
19 Treasurer to be distributed for early detection of breast and cervical cancer. The State Treasurer
20 shall distribute the contributions to the Cancer Prevention and Control Branch of the Division
21 of Public Health of the Department of Health and Human Services. Funds distributed pursuant
22 to this section shall be used only for early detection of breast and cervical cancer and shall be
23 used in accordance with North Carolina's Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program's
24 policies and procedures."

25 **SECTION 2.** The General Assembly finds that the funds generated by this act are
26 intended to be additional funding for early detection of breast and cervical cancer and are not
27 intended to replace current appropriations for early detection of breast and cervical cancer.

28 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 1,
29 2011 and expires for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2015.
