1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION HONORING THE TOWN OF WAGRAM ON THE TOWN'S
2 ONE HUNDREDTH ANNIVERSARY.

3 Whereas, the Scotland County Town of Wagram was incorporated by the General
4 Assembly on February 27, 1911; and

5 Whereas, the Town of Wagram, originally known as Montpelier and then as
6 Fontcal, was named by brothers and lumbermen James Williams and William Williams, who
7 settled in the area during the period of the American Revolution; and

8 Whereas, W.G. Buie, S.J. Womble, and E.C. Smith served as the first Town
9 commissioners and J.R. Bundy served as the first Town mayor; and

10 Whereas, the Town of Wagram's progress has led to the creation of essential
11 organizations and services that have improved the quality of life for the Town's citizens; and

12 Whereas, the Town of Wagram is the home of the Chalk Banks State Park, one of
13 North Carolina's Top 10 Natural Wonders, and the Lumber River, the only blackwater river in
14 North Carolina designated as a National Wild and Scenic River; and

15 Whereas, in preparation of the Town's centennial, the citizens of Wagram have been
16 working together to plan activities that recognize key moments and people throughout the
17 Town's history; and

18 Whereas, the Town of Wagram's centennial is worthy of celebration and should be
19 enjoyed and supported by all North Carolinians; Now, therefore,
20 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

21 **SECTION 1.** The House of Representatives honors the founders of the Town of
22 Wagram.

23 **SECTION 2.** The House of Representatives congratulates the Town of Wagram on
24 its 100th anniversary and encourages the people of this State to participate in activities
25 commemorating this special occasion.

26 **SECTION 3.** The Principal Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution
27 to the Mayor of the Town of Wagram.

28 **SECTION 4.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
