A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE ASSESSMENT ON HOSPITALS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR LOCAL INPATIENT PSYCHIATRIC BEDS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 108A-121, as enacted by S.L. 2011-11, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "§ 108A-121. Definitions. The following definitions apply in this Article:		
<u>(5.</u>	Mental health annual inpatient bed fund payment. – Ten million (\$10,000,000) during the first year of the assessment, adjusted thereafter by the General Assembly, to be used to fund inpatient health beds.	annually

- (d) State's Annual Medicaid—Payment. Payment and Mental Health Annual Inpatient Bed Fund Payment. The State's annual Medicaid payment and mental health annual inpatient bed fund payment must be allocated between the equity assessment and the UPL assessment based on the amount of gross payments received by hospitals under G.S. 108A-124.
