1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO COLLECT A FEE FOR DRIVER EDUCATION WHEN APPLYING FOR A
3 LIMITED LEARNER'S PERMIT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-11 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 20-11. Issuance of limited learner's permit and provisional drivers license to person**
7 **who is less than 18 years old.**

8 ...

9 (j) ~~Duration and Fee.~~Duration. – A limited learner's permit expires on the eighteenth
10 birthday of the permit holder. A limited provisional license expires on the eighteenth birthday
11 of the license holder. A limited learner's permit or limited provisional license issued under this
12 section that expires on a weekend or State holiday shall remain valid through the fifth regular
13 State business day following the date of expiration. A full provisional license expires on the
14 date set under G.S. 20-7(f).

15 (j1) Fees. – The fees for licenses issued under this section are as follows:

16 (1) The fee for a limited learner's permit ~~or for an applicant who did not~~
17 participate in the driver education program established under Article 14 of
18 Chapter 115C is fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

19 (2) An applicant for a limited learner's permit who did participate in the driver
20 education program established under Article 14 of Chapter 115C shall be
21 subject to the following fees:

22 a. Fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

23 b. Forty-five dollars (\$45.00), which shall be credited to the costs of
24 administering the driver education program established under Article
25 14 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes.

26 (3) The fee for a limited provisional license is fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

27 (4) The fee for a full provisional license is the amount set under G.S. 20-7(i).

29 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 115C-216(g) is repealed.

30 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2012.
