A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REDUCE CLASS SIZE IN KINDERGARTEN  
THROUGH THIRD GRADE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of ninety-two million eight hundred eighty-five thousand eight hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$92,885,877) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to reduce class size in kindergarten through third grade. Notwithstanding G.S. 115C-301 or any other law, local school administrative units shall have the maximum flexibility to use these additional teacher positions to maximize student achievement in kindergarten through third grade.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2012.
