**SENATE BILL 100**

Short Title: Injury Prevention Funds. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT TRAINING ON INJURY  
2 PREVENTION IN NORTH CAROLINA, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CHILD  
3 FATALITY TASK FORCE.

5       Whereas, injury is the leading cause of death for children above age nine; and

6       Whereas, it is critical that professionals across the State receive up-to-date training  
7 on injury; and

8       Whereas, the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Prevention Research  
9 Center has developed important infrastructure and expertise and has been providing training in  
10 this area; and

11       Whereas, grant funding for this important function is no longer available; Now,  
12 therefore,

13 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

14       **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
15 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred thousand dollars  
16 (\$200,000) for the 2011-2012 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars  
17 (\$200,000) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North Carolina at  
18 Chapel Hill Injury Prevention Research Center to provide training on injury prevention for  
19 professionals in North Carolina.

20       **SECTION 2.** The Injury Prevention Research Center shall coordinate its training  
21 efforts with the Department of Health and Human Services, Injury and Violence Prevention  
22 Branch, and shall provide annual reports on training to the Branch and to the General  
23 Assembly.

24       **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2011.
