**SENATE BILL 39
RATIFIED BILL**

AN ACT TO EXPAND THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF
PARMELE FROM THREE TO FIVE MEMBERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Effective with the organizational meeting after the 2011 regular municipal election and applying to the 2011 election and thereafter, Section 3 of Chapter 60 of the Private Laws of 1893 is rewritten to read:

"Section 3. The Board of Commissioners of the Town of Parmele consists of five members elected at large for four-year terms in 2011 and quadrennially thereafter. A mayor shall be elected by the qualified voters of the town in 2011 and quadrennially thereafter for a four-year term. The elections are conducted on the nonpartisan plurality basis and the results determined in accordance with G.S. 163-292."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 15th day of June, 2011.
