Short Title: Record of Excusals from Jury Duty. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF PERSONS EXCUSED  
3 FROM JURY DUTY BASED ON DISQUALIFICATION SHALL BE RETAINED BY  
4 THE CLERK OF SUPERIOR COURT FOR NOT LESS THAN TWO YEARS.  
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
6 SECTION 1. Article 1 of Chapter 9 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a  
7 new section to read:  
8 "**§ 9-6.2. Records of excusals from jury duty based on disqualification.**  
9 The name and address of each person who requests to be excused from jury duty on the  
10 basis that he or she is not qualified to serve as a juror under G.S. 9-3, along with the reason for  
11 that request, shall be retained by the clerk of superior court for not less than two years from the  
12 date of excusal and shall be a public record as defined in G.S. 132-1, except that medical  
13 information submitted to establish that an individual is not physically or mentally competent  
14 need not be retained by the clerk and shall not be made public."  
15 SECTION 2. G.S. 9-6(e) reads as rewritten:  
16 "(e) The judge shall inform the clerk of superior court of persons excused under this  
17 section, and the clerk shall keep a record of excuses separate from the master jury ~~list~~list in  
18 accordance with G.S. 9-6.2."  
19 SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
