A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AN EXECUTIVE HEAD AT ANY PRIVATE SCHOOL
2 FUNDED EXCLUSIVELY WITH PRIVATE FUNDS AND LOCATED IN FORSYTH
3 COUNTY MAY ADOPT A SCHOOL POLICY TO ALLOW CERTAIN SCHOOL
4 EMPLOYEES TO POSSESS AND CARRY A HANDGUN ON THE EDUCATIONAL
5 PROPERTY OF THE PRIVATE SCHOOL.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 14-269.2, the executive head of any private
9 school that is funded exclusively with private funds may adopt a school policy to allow an adult
10 employee who has a concealed handgun permit issued in accordance with Article 54B of this
11 Chapter or considered valid under G.S. 14-415.24 to possess and carry a handgun on the
12 educational property that is owned, used, or operated by the private school. The executive head
13 of the private school may also establish additional criteria that must be satisfied before an
14 employee may possess and carry a handgun on the private school's educational property and
15 may adopt policies and rules to regulate the possession and carrying of the handgun while the
16 employee is on the private school's educational property.

17 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding G.S. 14-269.2, an adult private school employee
18 may possess and carry a handgun on the educational property of a private school pursuant to
19 Section 1 of this act, provided the employee satisfies all of the following criteria:

- 20 (1) Has a concealed handgun permit issued in accordance with Article 54B of
21 this Chapter or considered valid under G.S. 14-415.24.
22 (2) Is in compliance with any additional criteria, policies, and rules adopted by
23 the executive head of the private school regarding the possession and
24 carrying of a handgun.
25 (3) Is on the private school's educational property.

26 **SECTION 3.** This act applies only to Forsyth County.

27 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2015.
