**BILL SUMMARY:**

Authorizes the Local Government Commission (LGC) to develop a curriculum and offer classroom instruction to local Finance Officers and authorizes the Commission to require a Finance Officer to attend the classes if the Commission finds deficiencies in their ability to perform the required duties. Allows the Commission to charge fees to recover the costs it incurs.

There will be a course curriculum developed by the LGC and they may work collaboratively with the Local Government Commission, UNC School of Government, the Community College System and other entities as needed. The bill allows the LGC to charge a fee for training Finance Officers which may include the costs for development of the curriculum.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:**

It is expected that any costs incurred by LGC for this effort would be offset by receipts from fees charged to classroom participants. It is not known what those costs will be to create the curriculum or in turn what the fee for attendance/training will be to local government Finance Officers.
