1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT REQUIRING AMBULATORY SURGICAL CENTERS AND OTHER
3 OUTPATIENT FACILITIES TO MAINTAIN AT LEAST ONE WHEELCHAIR ON THE
4 PREMISES FOR PATIENT USE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Article 6 of Chapter 131E of the General Statutes is amended by
7 adding a new section to read:

8 "**§ 131E-147.5. Wheelchair requirement.**

9 Each ambulatory surgical center licensed under this Article shall maintain at least one
10 wheelchair on the premises for patient use."

11 **SECTION 2.** Article 16 of Chapter 131E of the General Statutes is amended by
12 adding a new section to read:

13 "**§ 131E-266.5. Wheelchair requirement.**

14 Each of the following shall maintain at least one wheelchair on the premises for patient use:

- 15 (1) Outpatient departments, including a portion of a hospital operated as an
16 outpatient department.
17 (2) Oncology clinics.
18 (3) Kidney disease treatment centers."

19 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2017.
