1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR USED VEHICLES  
3 SOLD BY DEALERS ON A SALVAGE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-183.4C(a) reads as rewritten:

6 "(a) Inspection. – A vehicle that is subject to a safety inspection, an emissions  
7 inspection, or both must be inspected as follows:

8 ...

9 (2) ~~A~~Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, a used vehicle must be  
10 inspected before it is offered for sale at retail in this State by a dealer. Upon  
11 purchase, a receipt approved by the Division must be provided to the new  
12 owner certifying compliance. A dealer may sell, without inspection, a used  
13 vehicle issued a salvage certificate of title in accordance with the provisions  
14 of this Chapter if (i) no repairs have been made to the vehicle after issuance  
15 of the salvage certificate of title and (ii) the dealer discloses in writing on a  
16 form approved by the Division that no inspection has been performed.

17 ...."

18 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to used  
19 vehicles sold on or after that date.
