1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ALLOCATE THE UPPER LEVEL OF STATE PARKING DECK 65 TO THE  
3 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES COMMISSION AND TO AUTHORIZE A FEE FOR THE  
4 PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL LIGHTING AND SECURITY TO THE  
5 PARKING DECK.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 120-32.1 reads as rewritten:

8 "**§ 120-32.1. Use and maintenance of buildings and grounds.**

9 (a) The Legislative Services Commission shall:

- 10 (1) Establish policy for the use of the State legislative buildings and  
11 ~~grounds;grounds.~~
- 12 (2) Maintain and care for the State legislative buildings and grounds, but the  
13 Commission may delegate the actual work of the maintenance of those  
14 buildings and grounds to the Department of Administration, which shall  
15 perform the work as ~~delegated;delegated.~~
- 16 (3) Provide security for the State legislative buildings and ~~grounds;grounds.~~
- 17 (4) Allocate space within the State legislative buildings and ~~grounds;~~  
18 ~~andgrounds.~~
- 19 (5) Have the exclusive authority to assign parking space in the State legislative  
20 buildings and grounds.
- 21 (6) Have the authority to charge a fee of up to five dollars (\$5.00) per month for  
22 parking spaces located in the upper level of State Parking Deck 65. This fee  
23 is in addition to any existing parking fee and shall be used to provide  
24 additional lighting and security features for the parking deck. The authority  
25 to charge the fee only applies when the General Assembly is in regular  
26 session.

28 (d) For the purposes of this section, the term "State legislative buildings and grounds"

- 1           ~~a2.~~(1a) The areas between the outer walls of the State Legislative Building and the  
2           far curbline of those sections of Jones, Wilmington, Salisbury, and Lane  
3           Streets that border the land on which it is ~~situated;~~situated.  
4           ~~b.~~(1b) The Legislative Office Building, which shall include the following areas:  
5           ~~1.~~a. The garden area and outer ~~stairway;~~stairway.  
6           ~~2.~~b. The loading dock area bounded by the wall on the east abutting the  
7           Halifax Street Mall, the southern edge of the southernmost exit lane  
8           on Salisbury Street for the parking deck, and the Salisbury Street  
9           ~~sidewalk;~~sidewalk.  
10          ~~3.~~c. The area between its outer wall and the near curbline of that section  
11          of Lane Street that borders the land on which it is ~~situated;~~  
12          ~~and~~situated.  
13          ~~4.~~d. The area bounded by its western outer wall, the extension of a line  
14          along its northern outer wall to the middle of Salisbury Street,  
15          following the middle line of Salisbury Street to the nearest point of  
16          the intersection of Lane and Salisbury Streets, and thence east to the  
17          near curbline of the Legislative Office Building at its southwestern  
18          ~~corner;~~corner.  
19          ~~e.~~(1c) Any State-owned parking lot which is leased to the General  
20          ~~Assembly;~~Assembly.  
21          ~~f.~~(1d) The bridge between the State Legislative Building and the Halifax Street  
22          ~~Mall;~~Mall.  
23          ~~e.~~(1e) A portion of the brick sidewalk surface area of the Halifax Street Mall,  
24          described as follows: beginning at the northeast corner of the Legislative  
25          Office Building, thence east across the brick sidewalk to the inner edge of  
26          the sidewalk adjacent to the grassy area of the Mall, thence south along the  
27          inner edge of the sidewalk to the southwest outer corner of the grassy area of  
28          the Mall, thence east along the inner edge of the sidewalk adjacent to the  
29          southern outer edge of the grassy area of the Mall to a point north of the  
30          northeast corner of the pedestrian surface of the Lane Street pedestrian  
31          bridge, thence south from that point to the northeast corner of the pedestrian  
32          surface of the bridge, thence west along the southern edge of the brick  
33          sidewalk area of the Mall to the southeast corner of the Legislative Office  
34          Building, thence north along the east wall of the Legislative Office Building,  
35          to the point of ~~beginning;~~ and beginning.  
36          ~~f.~~(1f) From the center of Lane Street to the far curbline on the south side of the  
37          street; between the western edge of the Lane Street driveway to the gardens  
38          behind the State Records Center, and Wilmington Street.

40          (3) The upper level of State Parking Deck 65 located under the Halifax Street  
41          Mall."

42          **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
