2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY WHEN SUBSEQUENT COURT ORDERS WILL SUPERSEDE
3 SIMILAR PROVISIONS IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTIVE ORDERS, AS
4 RECOMMENDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA COURTS COMMISSION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 50B-7 reads as rewritten:

7 "**§ 50B-7. Remedies not exclusive.**

8 (a) The remedies provided by this Chapter are not exclusive but are additional to
9 remedies provided under Chapter 50 and elsewhere in the General Statutes.

10 (b) Any subsequent court order ~~entered supersedes similar provisions related to child~~
11 custody, child and spousal support, and possession of property issued under Chapter 50 or
12 Chapter 110 supersedes similar provisions in protective orders issued pursuant to this Chapter."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2020, and applies to orders in
14 effect on or after that date.
