A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF SUPERIOR COURT AND DISTRICT COURT
JUDGES IN ONSLOW, JONES, DUPLIN, AND SAMPSON COUNTIES AND TO
APPROPRIATE FUNDS.

Whereas, the most recent available data of the judicial branch workload formula developed by the Administrative Office of the Courts indicates that the superior court district containing Onslow, Jones, Duplin, and Sampson counties needs one additional superior court judgeship; and

Whereas, the same data indicates that the district court district containing the same counties needs two additional district court judgeships; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-41(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) The counties of the State are organized into judicial divisions and superior court districts, and each superior court district has the counties, and the number of regular resident superior court judges set forth in the following table, and for districts of less than a whole county, as set out in subsection (b) of this section:

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Administrative Office of the Courts the sum of three hundred thirty-eight thousand five hundred seventy-three dollars (\$338,573) for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective January 1, 2021, and elections conducted in 2020 shall be conducted in accordance with the judgeships created in those sections. Section 3 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2020. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
