3 METHODS FOR TELEPHONE SOLICITATIONS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 75-102 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 75-102. Restrictions on telephone solicitations.

7 ...

8 (i) No telephone solicitor shall ~~knowingly use any method to block or otherwise~~
9 ~~circumvent a telephone subscriber's use of a caller identification service.~~ cause misleading
10 information to be transmitted to users of caller identification technologies, or otherwise block or
11 misrepresent the origin of the telephone solicitation. No provider of telephone caller
12 identification services shall be held liable for violations of this subsection committed by other
13 individuals or entities. It is not a violation of this subsection for a telephone solicitor to utilize
14 the name and number of the entity the solicitation is being made on behalf of rather than the name
15 and number of the telephone solicitor.
