A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL RIGHTS
CENTER & MUSEUM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Sit-In Movement, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2019-2020 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to support the International Civil Rights Center & Museum in the City of Greensboro. The International Civil Rights Center & Museum, a national landmark and national site, is an archival center, collecting museum, and teaching facility devoted to the international struggle for civil and human rights and committed to memorializing the sit-in movement which is approaching its sixtieth year.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
