Short Title: Eligibility Reform/SNAP. (Public)

3 COOPERATE WITH THE STATE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM AS
4 A CONDITION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR BENEFITS UNDER THE SUPPLEMENTAL
5 NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SNAP).

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 108A-52 reads as rewritten:

8 "**§ 108A-52. Determination of ~~eligibility~~eligibility; cooperation with child support**
9 **enforcement program as a condition of eligibility.**

10 (a) Any person who believes that he or another person is eligible to receive electronic
11 food and nutrition benefits may apply for such assistance to the county department of social
12 services in the county in which the applicant resides. The application shall be made in such form
13 and shall contain such information as the Social Services Commission may require. Upon receipt
14 of an application for electronic food and nutrition benefits, the county department of social
15 services shall make a prompt evaluation or investigation of the facts alleged in the application in
16 order to determine the applicant's eligibility for such assistance and to obtain such other
17 information as the Department may require. Upon the completion of such investigation, the
18 county department of social services shall, within a reasonable period of time, determine
19 eligibility.

20 (b) The Department shall require applicants for electronic food and nutrition benefits to
21 cooperate with the Child Support Enforcement Program in accordance with Article 9 of Chapter
22 110 of the General Statutes as a condition of eligibility for food and nutrition benefits pursuant
23 to 7 C.F.R. § 273.11(o) and (p)."

24 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2020.
