A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE MODIFICATIONS TO APPOINTMENTS MADE IN THE 2019
APPOINTMENTS BILLS AND TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC
OFFICES UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF
THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

PART I. MODIFICATIONS

SECTION 1.1. Section 1.12 of S.L. 2019-122 reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 1.12.** Benjamin Curtis of Rockingham County and Pamela ~~Thomas-Thompson~~

37 for Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services for a term expiring
38 on June 30, 2022.
