1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMITS TO TWENTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR ON
3 RESIDENTIAL STREETS IN DURHAM EXPERIENCING CONGESTION, AS
4 DETERMINED BY THE CITY OF DURHAM'S TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT.
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 20-141(b)(1), it shall be unlawful to operate a
7 vehicle in excess of 25 miles per hour on residential streets in Durham experiencing congestion,
8 as determined by the City of Durham's Transportation Department.
9 **SECTION 2.** This act only applies to the City of Durham.
10 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses
11 committed on or after that date.
