A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE METHOD OF FILLING VACANCIES ON THE
WINSTON-SALEM/FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 2(a)(5)(iv) of Chapter 112 of the Session Laws of 1961, as amended by S.L. 2013-249, reads as rewritten:

"(iv) ~~Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 115C-37(f), all~~ All vacancies occurring during a term of office shall be filled by appointment by the remaining members of the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education for the unexpired term of the vacated ~~seat.~~ seat in accordance with G.S. 115C-37.1."

SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-37.1(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) This section shall apply only in the following counties: Alleghany, Beaufort, Brunswick, Carteret, Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Dare, Davie, Forsyth, Graham, Guilford, Harnett, Hyde, Iredell, Lee, Madison, New Hanover, Onslow, Pender, Rutherford, Stanly, Stokes, Surry, Vance, Washington, and Yancey."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to vacancies on the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education occurring on or after that date.
