A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INFORM THE PUBLIC ABOUT INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS AND ACTIVITIES USED IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS, COMMUNITY COLLEGES, AND CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

 SECTION 1.(a) Article 8 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 115C-98A. Inform the public about instructional materials.

- (a) The governing body of a public school unit shall ensure that the following information for each school it governs is prominently displayed on the school website at least 15 days prior to the start of each semester, organized, at a minimum, by subject area and grade level:
 - (1) The instructional materials and activities that were used at the school during the prior school year and all instructional materials to be used at the school in the current school year, including all of the following:
 - <u>a.</u> <u>Anything assigned, distributed, or otherwise presented in any course</u> for which a student receives credit.
 - <u>b.</u> <u>Any instructional materials from among which students are required</u> to select one or more if the selection is restricted by the school.
 - c. Any syllabus or similar document used to outline the covered material in any course for which a student receives credit.
 - (2) Any procedures for the documentation, review, or approval of the instructional materials used for student instruction at the school, including by the principal, curriculum administrators, or other teachers.
- (b) The information displayed shall include the information necessary to identify the instructional materials and activities used for instruction, including the title and the author, organization, or website associated with each instructional material and activity. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require the digital reproduction of the instructional materials themselves or the separate reporting of individual components of instructional materials produced as a single volume.
 - (c) The following definitions apply in this section:
 - (1) Activities. Any instructional task, including, but not limited to, presentations, assemblies, lectures, or other activities or events facilitated by the school, excluding student presentations.

SECTION 3. Part 2 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section to read:

"§ 116-18.5. Inform the public about course instructional materials and activities.

- (a) Each constituent institution of The University of North Carolina shall prominently display on the institution's website at least 15 days before the start of each academic semester at least the following information organized by course offering for the upcoming academic semester and from the prior academic year:
 - (1) The instructional materials used by and activities at the constituent institution, including all of the following:
 - a. Assignments that are distributed or otherwise presented in any course for which a student receives credit.
 - b. Any instructional materials students may select when one or more instructional materials are available, if the selection of instructional materials is restricted by the constituent institution.
 - (2) Any procedures for the documentation, review, or approval of the instructional materials or activities used for constituent institution courses, including approval by administrators and faculty.
- (b) The information displayed on the website shall include all information necessary to identify the instructional materials and activities used for the courses, including the title and the author, organization, or website associated with each instructional material and activity. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require the digital reproduction of the instructional materials or the separate reporting of individual components of instructional materials produced as a single volume.
 - (c) The following definitions apply in this section:
 - (1) Activities. Any instructional task, including presentations, assemblies, lectures, or other activities or events facilitated by the community college, excluding student presentations.
 - (2) <u>Instructional materials.</u> Any material used for instruction, including all textbooks, other reading materials, videos, digital materials, websites, and other online applications."

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 of this act applies beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. Sections 2 and 3 of this act apply beginning with the 2021-2022 academic year.
