SENATE BILL 233

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REVISE THE LAWS PERTAINING TO HUNTING AND TRAPPING IN
CUMBERLAND, HARNETT, RANDOLPH, AND GUILFORD COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of S.L. 2018-10 reads as rewritten:

"**SECTION 1.(a)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there is an open season for taking foxes with weapons and for foxes and coyotes by trapping during the trapping season set by the Wildlife Resources Commission each year, with no tagging requirements prior to or after sale.

"**SECTION 1.(b)** No bag limit applies to coyotes and foxes taken under this act.

"**SECTION 1.(c)** This section applies only to Cabarrus, Caldwell, Cleveland, ~~Cumberland,~~ Gaston, Guilford, Harnett, McDowell, Mitchell, Montgomery, Randolph, Rowan, Rutherford, Stokes, and Yancey Counties."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2021, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
