SENATE BILL DRS15228-LGa-91

Short Title: NC Stop Human Trafficking Funds. (Public)

Sponsors: Senator Davis (Primary Sponsor).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO NC STOP HUMAN TRAFFICKING.  
3 Whereas, NC Stop Human Trafficking, a nonprofit organization, is actively working  
4 with community organizations to help abolish human trafficking; and  
5 Whereas, NC Stop Human Trafficking collaborates with community organizations  
6 such as churches, civic groups, and other community groups to raise awareness of Human  
7 Trafficking, and to teach them how to identify human trafficking, with the goal of increasing  
8 referrals to the National Human Trafficking Hotline and improving victim response; and  
9 Whereas, NC Stop Human Trafficking also introduces fair trade products into the  
10 local markets. The demand for more products free of forced labor will lessen human trafficking  
11 globally; and  
12 Whereas, NC Stop Human Trafficking also advocates for stronger anti-human  
13 trafficking legislation on both the State and federal levels; Now, therefore,  
14 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
15 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to NC Stop Human  
16 Trafficking, a nonprofit organization, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for  
17 the 2021-2022 fiscal year to assist the organization in its efforts to abolish human trafficking.  
18 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2021.
