A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO FORSYTH TECHNICAL COMMUNITY  
COLLEGE TO DEVELOP A LAW ENFORCEMENT DRIVING TRAINING CENTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Community Colleges System Office the sum of six million one hundred thousand dollars (\$6,100,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2026-2027 fiscal year to be allocated to Forsyth Technical Community College (Forsyth Tech) to be used to establish a law enforcement driving training center in King, North Carolina, in partnership with the City of Winston-Salem. The center shall include a driving pad, roadway, and instructional building to be used as part of Forsyth Tech's Basic Law Enforcement Training and continuing education programs.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2026.
