2	AN ACT TO MODERNIZE MEDICAID DENTAL RATES.		
3	Whereas, good oral health is vital to good overall health, and untreated oral health		
4	conditions negatively affect overall health and have associations with chronic disease, including		
5	diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease, Alzheimer's disease, and even mental illness; and		
6	Whereas, the failure to adjust reimbursement rates to account for increasing inflation		
7	and costs over the last fifteen years has resulted in reduced dental provider participation in		
8	Medicaid; and		
9	Whereas, regular preventative dental care is the most cost effective method available		
10	to prevent minor oral conditions from developing into more complex oral and physical health		
11	conditions that would eventually require emergency and palliative care; and		
12	Whereas, in order to improve overall health and access to quality care, increase		
13	provider participation in Medicaid, and prevent future health conditions caused by overall health		
14	problems, it is in the best interest of the State to raise Medicaid reimbursement rates paid to dental		
15	care providers from 35% to 46% of the average dentist charges in 2023 in order to provide rates		
16	that are comparable with the Medicaid rates of surrounding states; Now, therefore,		
17	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
18	SECTION 1.(a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of		
19	Health and H	luman Services, Division of Health Benefits, the sum of fifty-two mil	lion dollars
20	(\$52,000,000)) in recurring funds for each year of the 2025-2027 fiscal biennium to	be used to
21	increase the N	Medicaid rates paid for dental services. These funds shall provide a Star	te match for
22	ninety-five n	nillion dollars (\$95,000,000) in recurring federal funds for each	year of the
23	2025-2027 fiscal biennium, and those funds are appropriated to the Division of Health Benefits		
24	for the same purpose.		
25	SI	ECTION 1.(b) The rate increases required by this section shall be imp	lemented as
26	soon as practicable after July 1, 2025.		
27	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2025.		



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
