The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 7B of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Part to read: "Part 7. Classroom Policies. "§ 115C-77.1. Cell phone-free education policy. Governing bodies of public school units shall adopt a cell phone-free education policy to eliminate or severely restrict student access to cell phones during instructional time. At the beginning of each school year, governing bodies of public school units shall notify parents of all students enrolled in the public school unit of the Cell Phone-Free Education
