SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of four million one hundred thousand dollars (\$4,100,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2025-2026 fiscal year to be allocated by the Superintendent of Public Instruction on a first-come, first-served basis to governing bodies of public school units in an amount sufficient to purchase and install one AED per school and train personnel on the proper use of the AED as required by this act.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2025, and applies beginning with the 2025-2026 school year.
