2	AN ACT REPEALING IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PERSONS WHO
3	ATTEND A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IN NORTH CAROLINA.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. This act shall be known as "The University Vaccination Freedom Act."
6	SECTION 2. G.S. 130A-154(b) reads as rewritten:
7	"(b) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a person who received
8	immunizations in a state other than North Carolina shall present an official certificate or record
9	of immunization to the child care facility, school (K-12), or college or university. facility or
10	school (K-12) of attendance. This certificate or record shall state the person's name, address, date
11	of birth, and sex; the type and number of doses of administered vaccine; the dates of the first
12	MMR and the last DTP and polio; the name and address of the physician or local health
13	department administering the required immunization; and other relevant information required by
14	the Commission."
15	SECTION 3. G.S. 130A-157 reads as rewritten:
16	"§ 130A-157. Religious exemption.
17	If the bona fide religious beliefs of an adult or the parent, guardian or person in loco parentis
18	of a child are contrary to the immunization requirements contained in this Chapter, the adult or
19	the child shall be exempt from the requirements. Upon submission of a written statement of the
20	bona fide religious beliefs and opposition to the immunization requirements, the person may
21	attend the college, university, school or facility without presenting a certificate of immunization."
22	SECTION 4. G.S. 130A-155.1 is repealed.
23	SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with

the 2026-2027 academic year.
