2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE INTENTIONAL RELEASE OF POLLUTING EMISSIONS,
3	INCLUDING STRATOSPHERIC AEROSOL INJECTION, CLOUD SEEDING, AND
4	ELECTROMAGNETIC RADIO FREQUENCY, INTO THE ATMOSPHERE TO ALTER
5	THE TEMPERATURE, WEATHER, OR THE INTENSITY OF SUNLIGHT.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 143-213 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
8	"(5b) The term "atmospheric modification" means stratospheric aerosol injection
9	(SAI), cloud seeding, electromagnetic radio frequency or microwave radiation
0	emissions, or other atmospheric polluting activity affecting temperature,
1	weather, intensity of sunlight, the environment, agriculture, wildlife, human
2	health and safety, aviation, state security, or the economy of the State. The
13	term does not include the application of pesticides via aircraft under a license
4	issued by the Pesticide Board pursuant to Article 52 of this Chapter."
15	SECTION 2. G.S. 143-215.108(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
16	"(5) <u>Intentionally inject, release, or disperse, by any means, chemicals, chemical</u>
17	compounds, substances, or apparatus within the borders of this State into the
18	atmosphere with the intentional and sole purpose of atmospheric
9	modification."
20	SECTION 3. The Environmental Management Commission shall adopt rules
21	necessary to implement this act.
22	SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
