6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
7	SECTION 1. G.S	5. 115C-407.55(1)b. reads as rewritten:	
8	"b. Enr	ollment and transfer requirements, including the following:	
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10	<u>3.</u>	If a public high school does not offer a particular sport, a	
11		student from that school may participate in the sport at the	
12		public high school closest to the student's school that has a	
13		program in that sport, subject to the terms and conditions	
14		applicable to a regularly enrolled member of that high school's	
15		student body, except that the high school may charge a	
16		reasonable fee for participation to a student who is not enrolled	
17		in the high school as established by the local board of education	
18		in accordance with G.S. 115C-47(6).	
19	<u>4.</u>	A private school or home school student may participate in a	
20		sport at the base public high school for the student's address,	
21		subject to the terms and conditions applicable to a regularly	
22		enrolled member of that high school's student body. If the	
23		student's base public high school does not have a program in a	
24		particular sport, the student may participate in the sport at the	
25		public high school closest to the student's base public high	
26		school that has a program in that sport, subject to the terms and	
27		conditions applicable to a regularly enrolled member of that	
28		high school's student body. The public high school may charge	
29		a reasonable fee for participation to a student who is not	
30		enrolled in the high school as established by the local board of	
31		education in accordance with G.S. 115C-47(6)."	
32		5. 115C-47(6) reads as rewritten:	
33	"(6) To Regulat	e Fees, Charges and Solicitations. – Local boards of education shall	

"(6) To Regulate Fees, Charges and Solicitations. – Local boards of education shall adopt rules and regulations governing solicitations of, sales to, and fund-raising activities conducted by, the students and faculty members in schools under their jurisdiction, and no fees, charges, or costs shall be



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collected from students and school personnel without approval of the board of 1 2 education as recorded in the minutes of said board; provided, this subdivision 3 shall not apply to such textbooks fees as are determined and established by the 4 State Board of Education. The local board of education shall publish a 5 schedule of fees, charges, and solicitations approved by the local board board, 6 including fees established to allow students not enrolled in a particular public 7 high school to participate in sports and other extracurricular activities, on the 8 local school administrative unit's Web site by October 15 of each school year 9 and, if the schedule is subsequently revised, within 30 days following the 10 revision."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with the 2025-2026 school year.
