March 26, 2025 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF ELECTRIC ASSISTED BICYCLE AND TO 3 AUTHORIZE LOCAL GOVERNMENT REGULATION. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-4.01(7a) reads as rewritten: 6 "(7a) Electric Assisted Bicycle. – A bicycle with two or three wheels that is 7 equipped with a seat or saddle for use by the rider, fully operable pedals for 8 human propulsion, and an electric motor of no more than 750 watts, whose 9 maximum speed on a level surface when powered solely by such a motor is 10 no greater than 20 miles per hour. watts that meets the requirements of one of 11 the following three classes: 12 Class 1 electric assisted bicycle. – A bicycle equipped with a motor a. that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and ceases to 13 assist once the bicycle reaches a speed of 20 miles per hour. 14 Class 2 electric assisted bicycle. – A bicycle equipped with a motor 15 <u>b.</u> that may propel the bicycle without pedaling but ceases to assist once 16 17 the bicycle reaches a speed of 20 miles per hour. Class 3 electric assisted bicycle. – A bicycle equipped with a motor 18 c. that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and ceases to 19 20 assist once the bicycle reaches a speed of 28 miles per hour." **SECTION 2.** Article 3 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding 21

SECTION 2. Article 3 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 20-171.3. Electric bicycles.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in G.S. 160A-300.2 and G.S. 153A-245.1, the operation of an electric assisted bicycle as defined in G.S. 20-4.01 shall be permitted on all roadways, bicycle lanes, and shared-use paths.
- (b) A person operating or riding as a passenger on a Class 3 electric assisted bicycle shall wear a helmet that meets federal safety standards."

SECTION 3.(a) Article 15 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 160A-300.2. Electric bicycles.

- (a) A city may regulate the use of electric assisted bicycles on any street, road, or highway within municipal limits. This authority shall include the following:
 - (1) Restricting the use of a class or classes of electric assisted bicycles on multiuse paths, sidewalks, or trails.
 - (2) Establishing speed limits on greenways or shared-use paths.

- 1 (b) A city may require the use of a helmet by a person operating or riding as a passenger
 2 on a Class 1 or Class 2 electric assisted bicycle.
 3 (c) A city may impose penalties for violations of this section."
 4 SECTION 3.(b) Article 12 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by
 5 adding a new section to read:
 6 "§ 153A-245.1. Regulation of electric bicycles.
 - A county may regulate the use of an electric assisted bicycle in accordance with G.S. 160A-300.2. Nothing in this section shall be deemed to restrict or repeal the authority of a city to regulate the use of an electric assisted bicycle."
 - **SECTION 4.** The Department of Transportation shall develop educational materials on the proper use and safety considerations of electric assisted bicycles.
- SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all electric assisted bicycle riders and passengers on or after that date.
